Every year, the PDLab organizes **training** on TFP that allow you to obtain the "**TFP Didactic Training Graduate**" certification.

The aim of the course is to acquire an overall good competence in TFP, i.e. to improve the ability to diagnose levels of personality organization, to provide structure and framework for treatment, to manage impulsive behaviors and to work with transference and countertransference. The objective is the therapeutic ability to promote an evolution of the borderline personality organization towards the neurotic organization.

The course is **aimed at psychotherapists**, **psychiatrists and psychologists** interested in the treatment and psychotherapy of Personality Disorders in individual, residential and long-term outpatient care settings - public and private.

At the end of the training the participants will be certified "TFP Didactic Training Graduate". For those wishing to also acquire the "TFP Therapist" certification, according to the rules of the International Society of TFP (ISTFP), at least 20 hours of supervision will be required. Certified training is provided by ISTFP Teachers and Supervisors
